

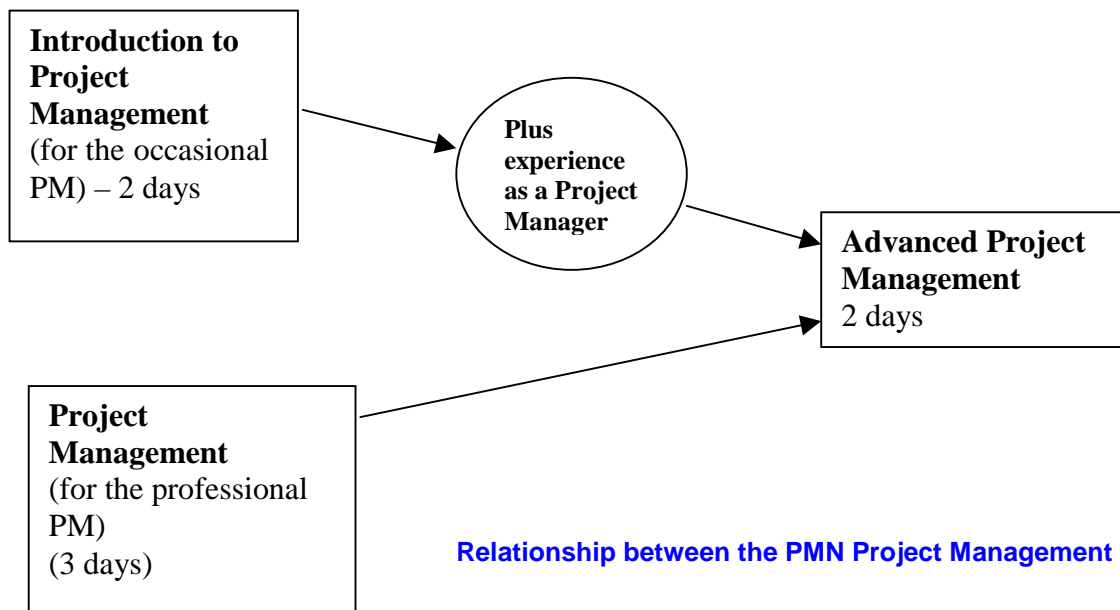


Project Management Training Courses

The training courses are offered publicly through major training providers and privately to groups within organisations.

We offer three levels of Project Management training

Introductory	Standard	Advanced
Introductory	aimed at introducing new project managers to the principles of project Management, especially where they do not undertake projects as the main part of their work. It is not a pre-requisite to the Standard course as it covers a lot of the same ground but does not pre-suppose any prior knowledge or understanding of projects.	
Standard	For those with some experience in Projects or in the PM role, and who expect to undertake projects regularly. Covers the whole of the Project Management Body of Knowledge with material not covered in Introduction to PM course	
Advanced	For experienced Project Managers wishing to expand and develop their knowledge of industry standards and practices

Course Follow-up

We all know that training not put into practice immediately is lost. Therefore PMN has developed an on the job portfolio assessment following the course. This allows participants to put into practice what they have learnt, and to obtain feedback from the course leader on their portfolio work.

This approach does not add significantly to the cost of training and increases its effectiveness for both the individual and the organisation.

Workshops on specific topics

Workshops on specific topics are also available. These are currently only conducted for in-house groups but may be offered publicly later on. The current topics are:

- Risk Management
- Supplier Management
- Metrics for Reporting

Related workshops for senior managers

To provide senior Managers with an appreciation of Project Management principles and current development we have a series of options available for them.

- Presentation on “Current trends and paradoxes in PM” – approximately 1.5 hours duration
- Half day or full day workshop in “Developing your Organisation’s Capability in PM”
